## **State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP)**

**FY2022 Available Funding:** \$185,024,690

**Eligible Applicants:** All 56 states and territories are eligible to apply for SLCGP funds.

**Application period began:** September 16, 2022

**Application deadline:** November 15, 2022 at 5:00pm ET

**Period of Performance:** 48 months

**Cost Share:** 90% Federal/10%Non-Federal

Forthcoming this fall is a \$6 million allocation to the [Tribal Cybersecurity Grant Program \(TCGP\)](#).

*Note: Currently slated to be a 4-year program*

## **Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC)**

### **FY2022 Federal Award Information**

State/Territory Allocation:	\$112,000,000
Tribal Set-Aside:	\$50,000,000
National Competition Subtotal:	\$2,133,000,000

**Application period begins:** September 30, 2022

**Application deadline:** January 27, 2023 at 3:00pm ET

**Period of Performance:** 36 Months

**Cost Share:** 75% Federal/25% Non-Federal

**National Competition Cap:** \$50,000,000

[Applicants may submit an unlimited number of hazard mitigation project subapplications](#) each valued up to [\\$50,000,000](#) federal share to the national competition.

### **Eligible Applicants:**

- > States
- > District of Columbia
- > U.S. territories
- > Federally recognized Tribal governments

*Note: Individuals, businesses, and non-profit organizations are not eligible to apply for BRIC funds; however, [an eligible applicant or sub-applicant may apply for funding on behalf of individuals, businesses, and non-profit organizations.](#)*

## Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program (TBCP)

The Infrastructure Investments and Jobs Act appropriated an additional **\$2 billion to TBCP**, an NTIA program previously implemented under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021. The TBCP directs funding to tribal governments to be used for the following initiatives:

- Broadband Deployment on Tribal Lands
- Telehealth
- Distance Learning
- Broadband Affordability
- Digital Inclusion

## American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) OF 2021

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 is latest relief package for COVID-19 which provides \$1.9 trillion in mandatory funding, program changes, and tax policies aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the pandemic. The U.S. Department of Treasury has published the Interim Final Rule (Guidance) and State and Local Aid Allocations.

### Period of Performance

The State, Local, and Tribal Aid Funds being administered by the U.S. Department of Treasury provides the following important dates:

All funds **must be obligated by:**

[December 31, 2024](#)

All funds **must be expended by:**

[December 31, 2026](#)
