Application Submission Deadline: 02/10/2023 at 5:00 p.m. ET

The AFG Program provides financial assistance directly to eligible fire departments, nonaffiliated emergency medical service (EMS) organizations, and State Fire Training Academies (SFTAs) for critical training and equipment.

The objectives of the AFG Program are to provide critically needed resources that equip and train emergency personnel to recognized standards, enhance operational efficiencies, foster interoperability, and support community resilience.

Eligible applicants include:

- Fire Departments
- Nonaffiliated EMS Organizations
- State Fire Training Academies
- Non-federal airport and/or port authority fire or EMS organizations

COORDINATED TRIBAL ASSISTANCE SOLICITATION (CTAS)
Grants.gov Deadline: March 21, 2023, 8:59 p.m. ET
Application JustGrants Deadline: March 28, 2023, 8:59 p.m. ET

This solicitation provides federally recognized tribes and tribal consortia an opportunity to apply for funding to aid in developing a comprehensive and coordinated approach to public safety and victimization. Most of the Department of Justice's (DOJ's) existing tribal government-specific programs are included in and available through this single Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS).

CTAS is not a program but a single solicitation to allow tribes to apply to seven separate grant programs from four grant-making offices. Each tribe or tribal consortium may submit only one CTAS application. This application can include proposals for project funding under one or more purpose areas (PAs). As such, multiple awards may be made in response to a single application.

NEWS FROM OFFICE FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME (OVC)

Submit your Population Certification by February 17, 2023

OVC is seeking population certifications from eligible applicants to signal their intent to apply for the noncompetitive FY 2023 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Formula Grant Program.

Population certifications will be used to determine formula award amounts for each applicant. Applicants will then be invited to submit a full application under a subsequent solicitation to be released later in 2023.

Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program (TBCP)

The Infrastructure Investments and Jobs Act appropriated an additional **\$2 billion to TBCP**, an NTIA program previously implemented under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021. The TBCP directs funding to tribal governments to be used for the following initiatives:

- Broadband Deployment on Tribal Lands
- Telehealth
- Distance Learning
- Broadband Affordability
- Digital Inclusion

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) OF 2021

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 is latest relief package for COVID-19 which provides \$1.9 trillion in mandatory funding, program changes, and tax policies aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the pandemic. The U.S. Department of Treasury has published the Interim Final Rule (Guidance) and State and Local Aid Allocations.

Period of Performance

The State, Local, and Tribal Aid Funds being administered by the U.S. Department of Treasury provides the following important dates:

All funds **must be obligated by:**

December 31, 2024

All funds **must be expended by:**

December 31, 2026
