



TRIBAL BROADBAND CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM (TBCP)

The TBCP provides new federal funding for grants to Eligible Entities to **expand access to and adoption of: (i) broadband service on Tribal Land; or (ii) programs that promote the use of broadband to access remote learning, telework, or telehealth resources.**

(Eligible Entities must submit a single application by the application deadline to be eligible for program funding).

- the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands on behalf of the Native Hawaiian Community, including Native Hawaiian Education Programs;
- a Tribal organization; or
- an Alaska Native Corporation.

Strengthening Mobility and Revolutionizing Transportation (SMART) Grants Program

APPLICATION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 10, 2023

Who is Eligible to Apply?

- a State;
- a political subdivision of a State;
- a Tribal government;
- a public transit agency or authority;
- a public toll authority;
- a metropolitan planning organization; and
- a group of 2 or more eligible entities detailed above, applying through a single lead applicant.

Which Projects are Eligible?

A SMART grant may be used to carry out a project that demonstrates at least one of the following:

- Coordinated automation
- Connected vehicles
- Sensors
- Systems integration
- Delivery/logistics
- Innovative aviation
- Smart grid

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) OF 2021

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 is latest relief package for COVID-19 which provides \$1.9 trillion in mandatory funding, program changes, and tax policies aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the pandemic. The U.S. Department of Treasury has published the Interim Final Rule (Guidance) and State and Local Aid Allocations.

Period of Performance

The State, Local, and Tribal Aid Funds being administered by the U.S. Department of Treasury provides the following important dates:

All funds **must be obligated by:**

December 31, 2024

All funds **must be expended by:**

December 31, 2026
