## **ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT**

**Anticipated to open for application: January, 2024**

The primary goal of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) is to meet the firefighting and emergency response needs of fire departments and non-affiliated emergency medical service organizations.

Since 2001, AFG has helped firefighters and other first responders obtain critically needed equipment, protective gear, emergency vehicles, training, and other resources necessary for protecting the public and emergency personnel from fire and related hazards.

Eligible Applicants:

- Fire Departments
- Non-Affiliated EMS Organizations
- State Fire Training Academies
- Non-federal Airport and/or Port Authority Fire or EMS Organizations

## **TRIBAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM**

The Tribal Cybersecurity Grant Program provides funding to eligible entities to address cybersecurity risks and threats to information systems owned or operated by, or on behalf of tribal governments.

**Grants.gov Deadline: January 10, 2024, 5:00 pm ET**

### **Eligibility:**

1. **Eligible Applicants**

Tribal governments.

“Tribal government” is defined at Section 2220A(a)(7) of the Homeland Security Act (codified as amended at U.S.C. § 665g(a)(7)) as the recognized governing body of any Indian or Alaska Native Tribe, band, nation, pueblo, village, community, component band, or component reservation, that is individually identified (including parenthetically) in the most recent published list of Federally Recognized Tribes.

2. **Applicant Eligibility Criteria**

Applicants must be a tribal government that is eligible for the program. Two or more tribal governments may apply together as a tribal consortium and submit one application for the consortium.

3. **Other Eligibility Criteria/Restrictions**

Each eligible tribal government is required to meet the following criteria for FY 2023:

- Submit a Cybersecurity Plan, Cybersecurity Planning Committee List, and a Cybersecurity Charter that aligns with the criteria detailed in this funding notice.
- Cybersecurity projects funded by the Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program (THSGP) may be considered for TCGP funding if not duplicative of the THSGP project(s).

# American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) OF 2021

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 is latest relief package for COVID-19 which provides \$1.9 trillion in mandatory funding, program changes, and tax policies aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the pandemic. The U.S. Department of Treasury has published the Interim Final Rule (Guidance) and State and Local Aid Allocations.

## **Period of Performance**

The State, Local, and Tribal Aid Funds being administered by the U.S. Department of Treasury provides the following important dates:

All funds **must be obligated by:**

**December 31, 2024**

All funds **must be expended by:**

**December 31, 2026**
